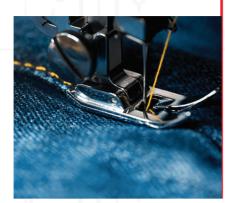

7. OUR ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT



In a continuous effort to reduce our environmental impact, we have adopted different energy saving projects, including:

The use of alternative illumination to maximize the utilization of natural daylight.

hydrotherapic processes to save up to 30% of electricity entering the station.

Using

The use of sensory systems in common areas.

Replacing all light sources with energy saving led sources.

A solar panel project expected to reduce our energy consumption by 50% when complete.

WATER

In collaboration with some of our clients, we aim to reduce our water consumption levels per unit produced. In doing so, we invest in water saving projects, including:

Operating new generation washing machines which use one glass of water per product, leading to 95% water savings and 75% chemical savings.

Expanding our laser unit, saving up to 100% in chemicals and water used in the dry processes, washing effect, and permanganate spray processes

Biologically treating up to 1,500 cubic meters of wastewater per day with the use of oxidation bacteria in our waste water treatment plant Investing in a water recycling project, which will allow us to not only treat our wastewater, but also reuse it, hence reducing our water consumption.

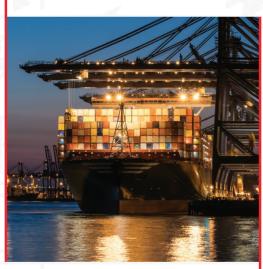

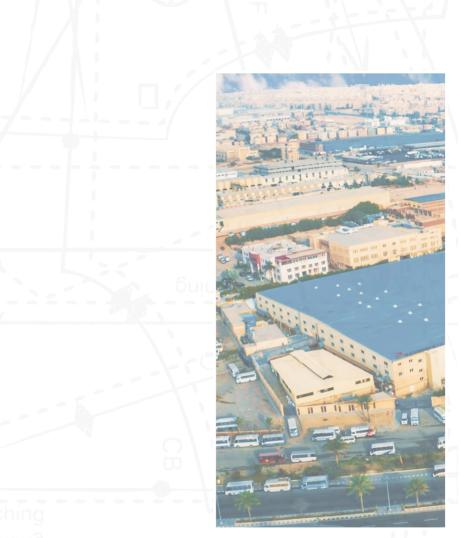












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
